The link below is an small example of an E190 Training Manual I developed. This is a basic format that followed the style convention in use at the time.

The document follows a heading 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 organizational structure with auto numbering, tables, and graphics.

It includes a Table of Contents, and List of Effective Pages often a requirement with FAA approved documents.

Keep in mind that Adobe FrameMaker uses a template based organizational structure. FrameMaker templates are highly customizable. We can add graphics, tables, List of Effective Pages, and a Table of Contents. Frame can use Hex or RBG codes to customize headings, paragraphs or bullets to any color on the spectrum. Over 16 million!

I also added an small Index to show the capability if your require one. Glossaries can be added if desired.

Our first step is to design a template that meets your needs in terms of design and presentation. I'll usually create one chapter or section and we can revise until the document standards and formats conform to your standard. This is an important step as we want to avoid "scope creep".
